This role will focus on driving the acquisition of new clients and partners, securing strategic partnerships and identifying new revenue streams to support Sea Ranger Service's expansion and impact. You will play a crucial role in the long-term sustainability of the organisation by driving our acquisition efforts, while also collaborating closely with other teams to achieve organisational goals. This is an entry-level position with the perspective to grow to a more senior level over time, depending on targets met.

Key Responsibilities

- Acquisition strategy: Collaborate on the creation and execution of a revised Sea Ranger Service acquisition strategy, with a focus on identifying and engaging new clients and partners.
- **Partnership development:** Cultivate and manage relationships with key clients, corporate partners and key individuals within the sectors in which we operate.
- **Revenue growth:** Identify and pursue new opportunities for revenue generation, including new service developments and supporting expansion planning.
- **Client stewardship:** Develop and implement strategies for client retention and stewardship to ensure long-term partnerships and sustained relationships.
- Market research: Stay up to date with trends in environmental work, marine conservation, and corporate social responsibility to continually optimise acquisition strategies.
- Cross-department collaboration: Work closely with the leadership team, communications and fundraising teams to align acquisition efforts with organisational goals and create compelling messaging that drives engagement.
- **Reporting and analysis:** Track and report on acquisition metrics, providing data-driven insights to refine strategies and improve outcomes.

- **Passion for marine conservation:** A strong commitment to Sea Ranger Service's mission and a deep interest in marine conservation and sustainability.
- **Travel willingness:** Willingness to travel domestically and internationally as needed for partnership and client meetings, events and other acquisition-related activities.

Who we are

We are a mission-driven organisation where a diverse team of employees passionately works on restoring nature at sea and create social impact within the wider sustainable blue economy. With our activities we contribute measurable impact to the UN Sustainable Development Goals 8 (work), 9 (infrastructure), 10 (reduced inequality), 13 (climate action), and 14 (life below water).


